

Child and Adolescent

Virtual URGENT Care Service

A visit to the Emergency Department can be daunting for children and their parents.

Our Child and Adolescent Virtual Urgent Care Service allows children who are *well enough* to avoid hospital and receive expert advice virtually, no matter where they are.



How it works:

- Scan the QR code to access the service.
- Similar to if you visited the Emergency Department in person, you'll first virtually speak with our administration team, followed by an emergency nurse who will provide an initial assessment of your child's condition, or refer you to another service.
- If needed, an emergency doctor will then assess your child and provide expert advice.
